

# COMPOST – GAME

## START (yellow arrow)

The player who throws six first starts. If there are more than 2 players then the same way determines who starts next (the one who throws six). The players throw the dice alternately (a web tool can also be used), or depending on the colored fields.

BACK 3 FIELDS	FORWARD 3 FIELDS
I put in the compost: 1 bones 2 sick plants 3 walnuts 4 weeds 5 the remains of cooked meals 6 meat 7 pinecones 8 batteries 9 plastic bags 10 chemicals	I put in the compost: 1 leaves 2 tea bags 3 coffee sediment 4 egg shells 5 the remains of fruits and vegetables 6 straw 7 grass 8 bark of trees 9 pine needles 10 sawdust

## MISS ONE ROLL OF THE DICE

- 1 You threw the remains of the fruit into the trash. Think!
- 2 You threw the egg shells into the trash. Think!
- 3 You threw the bones in the composter. Think!
- 4 You threw the chewing gum in the composter. Think!

(wrong answer: back to start, correct answer: throw the dice one more time)
